

Micro-Internship Program

A Micro-Internship is a short-term project that can be completed within 5-40 hours by a college student or recent grad. Most are completed remotely and are typically due within a week to a month. These projects allow students nationwide to receive paid, professional experience with organizations large and small.

Frequently Asked Questions

- Over 98% success rate: Students are inherently motivated to exceed expectations (and if they don't, you can select a different student or receive a refund)
- You define the project: Define what you need and when you need it (typically a few days to a few weeks out), and can use our templates to help
- **Remote or Onsite:** It's up to you, but over 95% of Micro-Internships are completed remotely so that you can engage with all students, even those with time constraints or limited access to transportation.
- Not your employees, interns, or contractors: Micro-Interns are employees or contractors
 of Parker Dewey for the duration of the project
- You select the Micro-Intern you want: You only see those students who applied for your project, and you can make the selection based upon your goals
- NDA and assignment: All Micro-Interns are under NDA, as is Parker Dewey itself
